Teacher Educators: where do we work?



Bachelor – 4 year-program for Primary Education:

Teacher Education Institute – PABO (mostly part of University of Applied Sciences)

Bachelor – 4 year-program - grade-two (lower secondary + vocabulary) school - subject certification

Teacher Education Institute (mostly part of University of Applied Sciences)

Master – 1 year-program - grade-one (upper secondary) school - subject certification Teacher Education Institute (mostly part of University of Applied Sciences) or University

Or teachers educators work in 'teaching schools' / Ausbildungsschule.
